- 1. To work for the welfare and upliftment of society through constructive and humanitarian activities.
- 2. To undertake health-related initiatives with prior approval from authorities, including health awareness programs, sanitation, cleanliness drives, blood donation camps, eye check-up camps, and medical support services.
- 3. To promote unity, brotherhood, harmony, and social integration among people from diverse backgrounds.
- 4. To promote moral, ethical, and value-based education by establishing and supporting schools, colleges, and educational institutions, and by organizing training programs and competitive activities.
- 5. To establish and manage schools, colleges, technical institutions, and universities for providing professional and vocational education, and to support employment-oriented services through training and skill development programs.
- 6. To promote technical education by establishing and operating training centres, ITIs, polytechnic institutes, and engineering colleges, and by organizing training camps and competitions to encourage technical excellence.
- 7. To operate and manage schools, colleges, and non-formal education centers such as literacy centers and cultural education centers.
- 8. To provide assistance and support to helpless, elderly, disabled, and economically weaker sections of society.
- 9. To conduct awareness campaigns for de-addiction and to establish and operate de-addiction and rehabilitation centers.
- 10. To work in the field of environmental protection and conservation, including plantation activities with due permission from authorities.

- 11.To undertake social, cultural, religious, and humanitarian activities for overall community development.
- 12.To promote social and economic development of society through various welfare initiatives.
- 13. To work for women and child development and actively participate in programs related to their welfare and empowerment.
- 14. To guide, support, and provide training to self-help groups and community-based organizations.
- 15.To conduct awareness campaigns and promotional activities under national cleanliness initiatives such as the Swachh Bharat Abhiyan.
- 16. To provide training and awareness in accordance with international standards of organic and natural farming practices.
- 17. To promote and encourage organic farming and sustainable agricultural practices through outreach and capacity-building programs.
- 18. To organize, manage, and support various regional, national, and international educational, cultural, and social activities.
- 19. To act as a motivating and facilitating organization for implementing employment-oriented programs and development schemes aimed at overall societal progress.
- 20.To establish and manage welfare institutions such as hostels, shelters, old age homes, women shelter, child care homes, training centres, and community workspaces for holistic social development.
